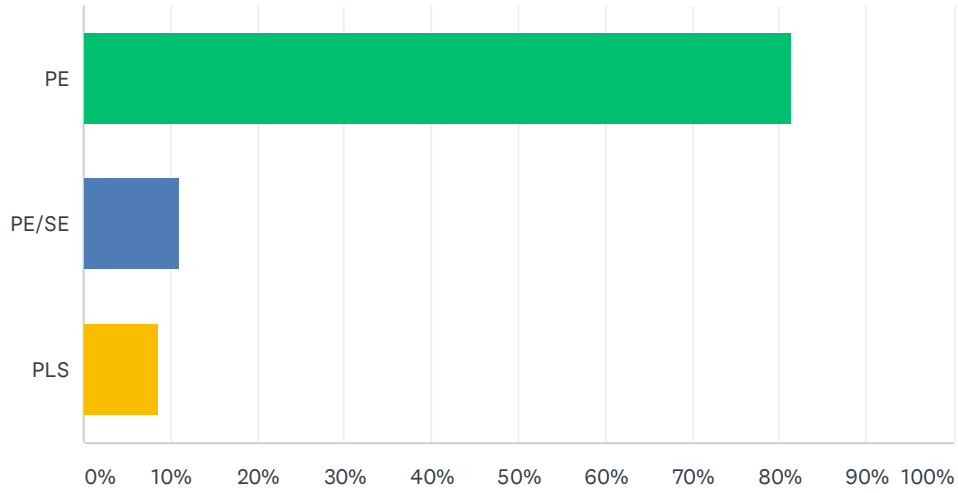


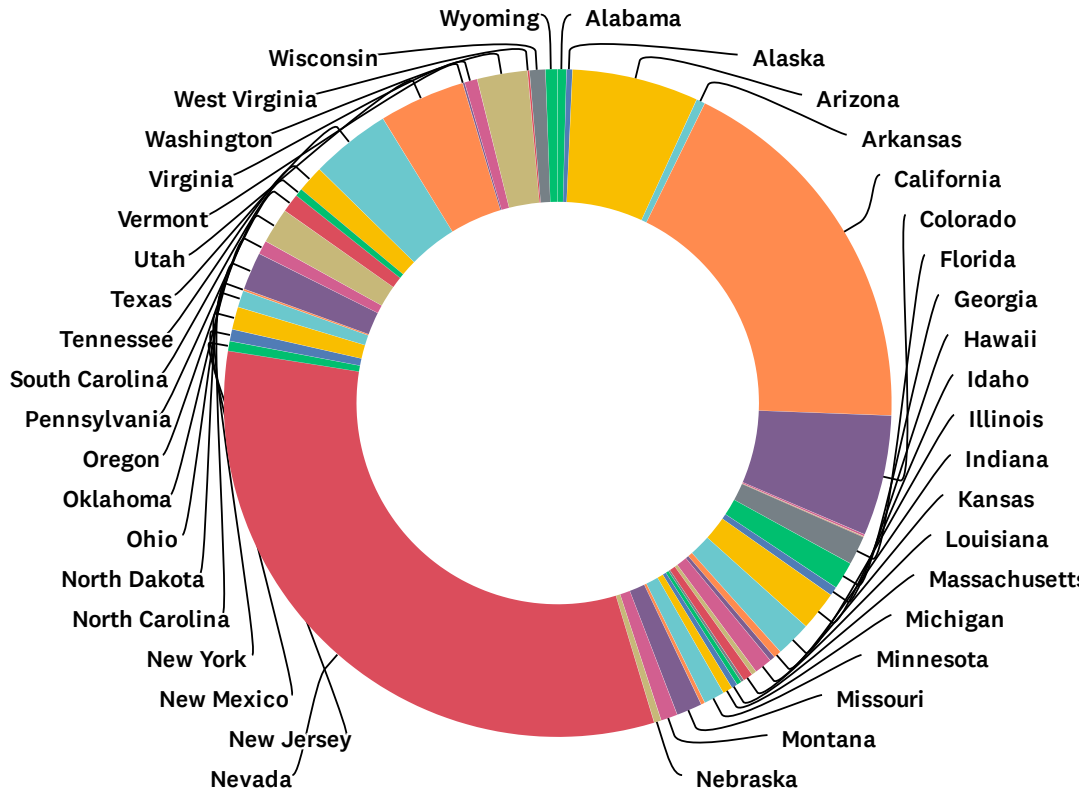
## Q1 Professional License Type?

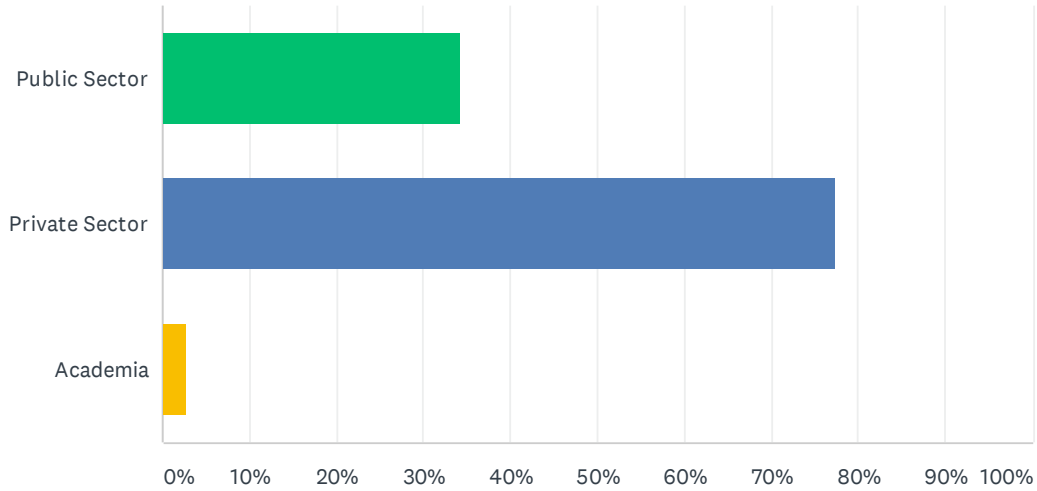

### Q3 What is your area of practice?

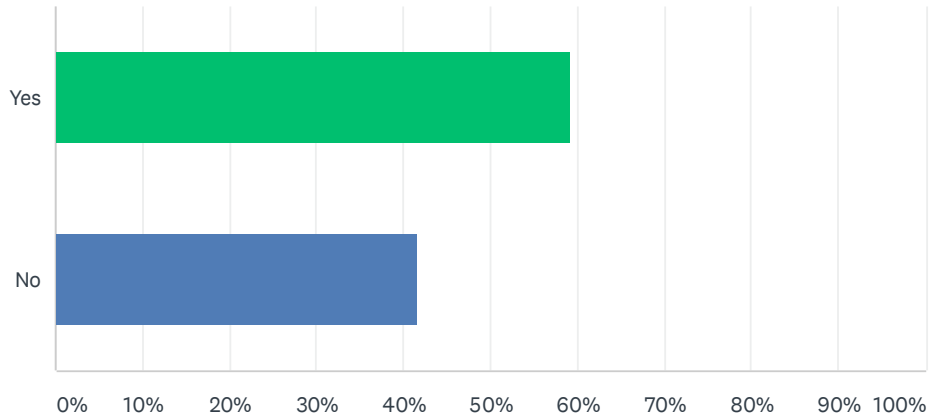

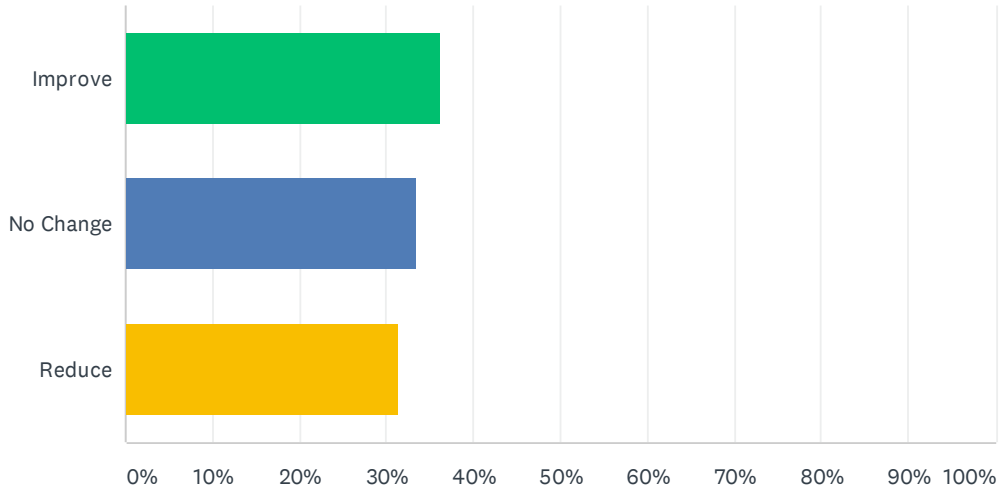
