

The following regulation was repealed, effective December 2020

NAC 625.360 Examinations: Reapplication after failure of certain oral examinations. ([NRS 625.140](#)) An applicant who fails to pass an oral examination, other than an oral examination given pursuant to [NAC 625.240](#), may reapply to take the oral examination:

1. Four months or more after failing the first oral examination.
2. Twelve months or more after failing the second oral examination.
3. Twenty-four months or more after failing the third oral examination.
4. A reasonable time as determined by the Board after failing the fourth oral examination.
